It has been a lovely first few days back at school this week. The children have all settled into their new classes really well and there is a fantastic, calm and purposeful atmosphere around the whole school. Our new pupils and staff members have settled in extremely well and are quickly getting to know everybody.

In line with DfE recommendations, we have made some changes to our policy regarding administering medicines in school. If your child needs to take medicine during school time on a regular basis, you will have been already given a form to complete detailing doses etc. We are no longer able to keep a stock of Calpol, Ibuprofen and Piriton in school to administer to the children. If at any time your child does need to take medicines during school time (including Calpol, antibiotics etc.), you will need to bring the medicine into school in its original container and complete a dosage form which is attached to this Flyer.

Can I also please ask parents to be considerate about parking on the playground before and after school. There should be no parking on the driveway to the playground as this makes it difficult for cars coming in and out. At the end of the day, the gates will be opened shortly after 3pm and then will be locked at 4pm. Please make sure that you are clear of the playground by this time.
